Include both on and off stage involvement, year or age involved, and recognitions if applicable. Include all programs – Pierre Player sponsored events, High School activities and community involvement.
2. **Essay.** In 150-200 words, please describe how participation in the fine arts programs listed above has impacted your life.
3. **Recommendations:** Please attach two (2) letters of recommendation from adults in the community. Recommendations cannot be a relative and **only one** may be from a High School teacher.
